From the North, take I-35W (South). At exit 24, turn right onto ramp. Turn left (South) onto Long Lake Road. Turn left (East) on to CR-23 [County Road C W]. Turn right onto Cleveland Avenue N and follow it .2 Miles to the Radisson Roseville.

From the South, take I-35W (North). At exit 24, turn right onto ramp. Turn right (South) on to CR-46 [Cleveland Avenue N]. Follow Cleveland Avenue N .2 miles to the Radisson Roseville.

From the East and West, take I-94 [US-12] to SR-280. Take SR-280 (North) 3.2 miles. Take the ramp (RIGHT) on to I-35W. Follow I-35W 1.6 miles. At exit 24, turn right onto ramp. Turn right (South) on to CR-46 [Cleveland Avenue N]. Follow Cleveland Avenue N .2 Miles to the Radisson Roseville.
